- A screenshot of Payment details (UTR/Ref. No must be there) needs to be sent with the Abstract/ Paper.
- The title page should contain the Title of the paper, the full name of the author(s) with designation, the Institute's name, postal address, Email ID, and contact number. **Sub-theme** should be mentioned on the title page of the paper. No decoration in the article is accepted.
- The paper must be in IMRAD format.
- Case studies and case series must be as per the CARE criteria. The title should include case study/case report/case series. In case study and case series, there should be follow-up of the case/s.
- Do not add references in the footer. Give appropriate numbers in the text for the references (in the superscript). Referencing must be according to the Vancouver style of referencing.
- Tables, charts, diagrams and images should be in the end after references.
- Spelling must be according to American English.
- It must be either in English or Hindi (Google input font). Please don't mix two languages in one sentence and in one paragraph.
- Abstract and incomplete papers will not be accepted.
- The author (s) needs to send the full paper with duly signed PDF consent from the Author(s).
